# FORMER ST THOMAS CHURCH SITE, PALLISTER AVENUE, BRAMBLES FARM, MIDDLESBROUGH, TS3 9BE

### Location

The land is located on Pallister Avenue in Brambles Farm, a predominantly residential area directly to the south of the A1085 Longlands Road and approximately 2 miles to the east of Middlesbrough town centre.

The land immediately to the west has recently been developed for social housing by Thirteen Housing Group.

## **Description**

The site was formerly the St Thomas' Church which has subsequently been demolished.

The site is currently cleared and left to grass and is secured by way of a perimeter fence.

The southern half of the site is accessed from the cul-de-sac off Pallister Avenue with the northern half of the site accessed off Cherwell Terrace.

The site was granted planning permission on 19 December 2024 for a development of 17, 2 and 3 bed houses.

6 - 3 bed semi detached,

10 - 2 bed semi detached

1 - 3 bed detached.

The planning permission expires in December 2027
